ADULT EDUCATION

Rev. Debra will begin a new adult book study on Sunday, 1/8/2023 at 9:00 a.m. in the Fireside room. The class will be studying the book *Holy Envy: Finding God in the Faith of Others*. The author, Barbara Brown Taylor, is a bestselling author and shares her experiences teaching World Religions at a small college in rural Georgia. She writes about falling in love with parts of every religion she taught, feeling a Holy Envy for their practices. The book jacket says, "Taylor tackles the questions, worries, and concerns that arise when we encounter "difference" and others. It is not a primer on religion: instead, she explores what is opened and what is revealed when we accept the invitation to investigate all the wonder before us." Taylor shares insights into: Hinduism, Buddhism, Judaism, Islam, and Christianity. Rev. Debra shares that she fell in love with the book, which led her to seek out more information about how God is revealed through other faith traditions. While not an in-depth study of religions, instead it serves to open our eyes to how others in the world experience the Holy. Books will be available in the church office for \$13.00. Altar On The Hill

The song, *"Altar on the Hill"* was composed by Reverend Sandy Stephens, who was at the time, our youth pastor. It was written for the dedication Sunday of our new church building in April of 1979. It describes the symbolism in the window that had been designed and would be installed later.

Its simple tune tells the story of how our church evolved from a few families meeting in a nearby home to the building we now cherish.

The refrain states, *"The living water flows from the altar on the hill, bringing life in wide, and ever-widening streams."* You can see the river flowing in the stained glass window. This symbolism continues with the river rocks flowing down the hill outside the North entrance.

Not only did Reverend Stephens write this tribute to our mission, but she is also the reason we have the baby grand piano in the sanctuary. She performed a **one-person pian-o-thon** to raise the money to purchase it. The wee hours of that morning were rough, but she had a group of supporters at her side, cheering her on and making song requests.

The end of the last refrain continues at our 60th anniversary. *"We the people of Green Mountain join our hands to do God's will, praising him who still is giving life to dreams."*



GMUMC Online Directory

There are two ways to access the church online directory with pictures of members, their phone numbers, and emails. The church office will need to have put your information into the directory in order for you to open and use directory.

Here are the two methods.

- 1. Go to the church website, <u>gmumc.com</u>, and click on "directory" which is on the bottom bar of the home page. You may either download or open the directory. You will need the church password, so call the church office at 303-989-3727 to obtain the directory password.
- 2. Download the app on your smart phone or tablet: Instant Church Directory by Communication Resources (a yellow church icon). The app will ask for your email address (which must be in the directory), and then you can set a password. You can get the app on Google play, the Kindle store, or the Apple store.

King Soopers Community Rewards



As many of you know King Soopers has ended its gift card program. In its place, they

have initiated the Community Rewards Program. This is a just a reminder for those of you who need to link their SooperCard, so that the church will still be getting money for your shopping at King Soopers

You will need to create a digital account by going twww.KingSoopers.com/CommunityRewards.

You will then select **Create an Account**. Under sign-in information, enter your email and create a password (write down your password, you will need it in step 2). Select 'Use Card Number' and enter your SooperCard Number or Alternate ID, last name, and zip code. Under 'Select your Store,' enter your zip code and then select 'Find Stores.' Choose your store and then select 'Create Account.' Once you get the welcome email, then you can go back in clicking on the link in the email and finish creating your account. Then click on the Community Rewards link on the left hand side and either search by Green Mountain United Methodist Church or use this number to find us: RK117, which is our organization code. 


